Who is eligible for camp and how does grouping work?

We enroll students from 3rd to 8th grade. During the camp day, students will be split up by age and come together during full camp rehearsals and also for the performance.

Group A- 3rd-4th graders

Group B- 5th-6th graders

Group C- 7th-8th graders

What do you do at theater camp?

The day consists of a rotation of acting, singing, and dancing. There is a daily schedule and the teacher will rotate between groups.

Dance Class- In dance class, students will learn the choreography for the camp show on the last day!

Singing Class- In singing class, students will be taught the material for the camp show, learn basic vocal warm-up and techniques, and even work on some solo performing!

Acting Class- In acting class, students will not only work on scenes, but they will also see the technical side of the theater - touching on design elements, theater games, crafts, and more!

Will classes be inside or outside?

We are lucky to have the option to do both. Weather permitting some classes will be held outside. You will know ahead of time and classes will not be outside if it is too hot.

Is there a dress code?

We asked that all students wear sneakers because they will be dancing for a portion of the day. This year we also require a face mask that will be supplied. You may also use your own face mask.

Is there a performance?

Yes, on the last day of each session, the student will perform a quick free showcase of all the material they have learned during their weeks at camp! Weather permitting, we will be using the bleachers and space in the back of Center Stage at Gracie Field.

Where is the camp located?

This year, the camp will be located at our air-conditioned 54 Grove street location.

How many students per classroom?

The cap of students in the past is usually much larger, but following CDC guidelines, we will have 10 students in a group.

How does check out work?

Each student is required to check out with a staff member daily. We must see the adult picking you up, and that adult must be on the approved list of contacts. If there are any changes please send a note in the morning.
